Freedom for Palestine! End the Israeli Occupation!

On Saturday 9th June, Tayside for Justice in Palestine is organising a Justice for Palestine festival in Dundee City Square from 12pm to 4pm.

45 years ago Israel began its occupation of Palestine. Daily life for Palestinians under this occupation continues to be desperate. The West Bank and the Gaza Strip are like giant prison camps, patrolled by the Israeli army on land, sea and air. The Israelis decide who, and what, goes in or comes out. Many of the people are expected to live on \$2 per day and rely on the UN for food.

The Justice for Palestine festival is about showing solidarity with the Palestinian resistance to the Israeli occupation. It will highlight issues linked with the Palestinian struggle and the Israeli occupation, including refugees, the Nakba, the Israeli settlements and the Boycott, Divestment & Sanctions campaign.

Performers will include young Palestinian dancers from the Lajee Centre based at Aida refugee camp in Bethlehem and Loadsawimminsignin, the Dundee Rep women's singing group.

There will also be a new art installation by Dundee artist, Pat Donachie, entitled *Medals of Shame*.

Speakers confirmed at the moment include Jim Malone (FBU), Dr Colin Cooper (Gaza Medical Aid), Sofia McLeod (Stop the JNF) and Mick Napier (SPSC).

There will be stalls selling Palestinian produce and providing information about different aspects of the Palestinian struggle and the Israeli occupation.
